## **ISSUE**

An inoperative or inaccurate speedometer may be caused by a speedometer cable that is kinked or broken.

### **ACTION**

Inspect the speedometer cable for kinks or breakage. Replace the cable if it is damaged. Refer to the following procedure for service details.

- 1. Check speedometer operation for signs of improper operation.
- 2. Inspect speedometer cable for kinks or breakage.
- 3. Replace the speedometer cable if there are any signs of damage. Refer to page 33-10-3 of the 1991 Capri Shop Manual for service details.

#### **NOTE**

TORQUE SPEEDOMETER CABLE CONNECTION AT TRANSAXLE TO 3-5 LBS.-FT. (4-7 N•m).




Figure 1 - Article 92-13-9

- 4. Reroute speedometer cable. Refer to Figure 1.
- Secure the speedometer cable to the brake master cylinder with a tie strap. Refer to Figure 1.
